#### **Responsibility:**

**All students should be at school at 8.30.** This ensures that they are ready to start the day. A bell goes at 8.50am which signals to students to go to their rooms to get ready for the start and the day. This is also a signal to parents that it is time to say goodbye and leave the school.

At the end of the day, **all parents should wait outside the classroom** until the bell has gone and the students are dismissed. **Every student should be responsible for their own clothing, book bag, school bag and personal belongings.** Please encourage and support them to take responsibility for these things. After school all children should have left the school grounds by 3.15 unless they are with a parent.
